Yosemite Equipment Rev 07/07/2008

Individual Food

1. Bear-Resistant Food Canister (buy or rent \$5 at Yosemite)
2. Cup (metal sierra cup), spoon (metal), dunk bag (mesh wash bag)
3. Water bottles (4 quarts total), this includes Camelback or Platypus (to drink from while hiking)
4. Food for 7 days, (re-supply at Tuolumne Meadows)
5. One gallon Zip lock plastic bags (7) for garbage

Individual Sleeping

1. Tent (backpacking)
2. Sleeping bag (25°F)-put mummy bag in plastic trash compactor garbage bag, then in stuff sack to keep dry
3. Sleeping bag sheet (to keep bag clean), Pillow case (optional)
4. Sleeping pad (closed cell foam)
5. Therm-a-Rest pad (optional), Therm-a-Rest repair kit (optional)

Individual Clothes

1. Stuff bag for clothes
2. Two Tee-shirts (troop green)
3. Socks four pairs
4. Underwear four pairs
5. Handkerchief
6. Rain suit (top and bottoms)
7. Sun hat (day time), ski hat (night time),
8. Jacket (polar fleece),
9. Quick dry long pants (no blue jeans), hiking shorts
10. Hiking boots
11. Underwear top or long sleeve shirt
12. 25 feet rope 1/8 dia. (for repair and clothes line)

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Individual Personal

1. Backpack, straps or rope to tie equipment to backpack
2. Hiking Stick (optional) (great for going uphill and downhill for adults)
3. Small personal first aid kit,
4. Small LED flashlight or headlamp, small pocketknife
5. Toothbrush, small toothpaste (optional)
6. Poop Kit (plastic shovel, toilet paper, baby wipes, and sanitary supplies)
7. Money (\$20 - \$40 in small bills) can use in backcountry
8. Water purification tablets 30 (MicroPur)
9. Camera (optional), compass (optional), whistle (optional), comb (optional), pen and paper (optional), backpacking chair (optional)
10. Pack cover (optional)

Shared Crew Equipment

1. 3 backpacking stoves (Jack Kelly)
2. 5 (8oz) bottles fuel for stoves, lighters (Jack Kelly)
3. Crew first aid kit (Jack Kelly)
4. Duct Tape small roll (Mike Crowley)
5. Sewing kit with heavy thread and needle (clothes and tent repair kit) (Ann Connelly)
6. Backpack repair kit (Ann Connelly)
7. Maps (Jack Kelly)
8. Nylon dining fly 12 x 12 (Jack Kelly)
9. Pair hot-pot tongs (Jack Kelly)
10. Dishwater soap (CampSuds) (Jack Kelly)
11. Scrub pads (Jack Kelly)
12. Cooking pots 3 (Jack Kelly, Mike Crowley, Ann Connelly)

Each crew member will carry about 1 pound of shared crew equipment.

We will wear Class A uniform while traveling.

Class A uniform: Scout shirt, scout pants, scout belt, neckerchief.

Wear a pair of underwear and socks for the first travel day and another two pairs for the next two days in Yosemite plus bring a set for the return travel day. Store this and towel in a sport bag. We will leave this in the cars at Yosemite. We can not have any smellables in the cars. We will buy soap and shampoo at Yosemite.

Bring money for: 4 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 4 dinners and snacks driving to and from Yosemite. Also bring money for souvenirs. Also bring some money for the backcountry.
