

NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Course

A NRA Certified Instructor will lead the participants in the basic knowledge, skills and attitude necessary for owning and using a pistol safely. Even if you do not own a pistol, this course is a valuable safety training aid.

All equipment will be supplied. The instructor will supply training materials, pistol, safety glasses, ear protection, ammunition and targets. There is a \$15 cost.

This course is open to all Scouts and their parents. For Venturing Scouts this course can be used for the Shooting Sports elective for the Ranger Award.
