



Camping Equipment

Jack Kelly weekend personal equipment

Food

Stuff sack for food use only (about 5 inch x 18 inch, 8 liters, waterproof)
Water Bottles (2 one liter bottles-Nalgene) and (a 2 liter Platypus with drinking tube) and small squirt bottle (at night in tent)
Spoon (metal), Cup (titanium, sierra cup), Pot gripper (metal), spoon 8.6 inches (metal), dunk bag
Stove – SnowPeak autostart, Fuel (3.5 oz isobutane), lighter, matches
Cooking Pot (0.9 liter titanium cooking pot)
Food and a one quart plastic zip lock bag for garbage

Troop

Leave No Trace Campfire Kit (aluminum foil, starter log (8 oz), lighter)
First Aid Kit, Emergency Blanket, Plastic Whistle, Katadyn MicroPur MP-1 (water purifier tablets)
Two Ropes 50 feet each 1/8 dia, with Bear throw bag (small stuff sack)
25 feet of rope 1/8 dia (for trying equipment on backpacks)

Sleeping

Sleeping Bag in compactor plastic bag then in stuff sack (mummy bag 25 degrees or better)
Sleeping bag liner for mummy bag (to keep the sleeping bag clean)
Tent, Big Agnes, Fly Creek UL1 (backpacking - 3 pounds or less)
Pillow Therm-A-Rest small 12 x 16 in, Therm-A-Rest pillow case
Polar fleece socks (sleeping only)
Therm-a-Rest pad NeoAir regular (sleeping air pad), Therm-a-rest repair kit
Closed cell foam pad, Therm-A-Rest RidgeRest (sleeping pad)

Radio

HAM radio, Plastic zip lock bag to store HAM radio at night

Clothes

Water proof stuff sack for clothes, 4 liters, about 9 x 15 in
Troop Tee-shirt, only one
Hiking socks SmartWool (one pair for each day)
Underwear (one pair for each day)
Polar fleece jacket
Hiking boots
Hiking shorts and a pair of quick dry camping long pants
Sun hat for the daytime, Ski hat for night
Long underwear (tops and bottoms)
Gloves for night
Rain suit (pants and tops)
handkerchief (2)

Personal

Crazy Creek chair, Map (7.5 minute topo), Trail profile, Compass, GPS, Monoscope (7x18 Brunton)
Two Hiking Sticks (collapsible), Knee braces (2)
LED headlamp, Toothbrush, no toothpaste
Small Pocket knife (Swiss army), Pen (space pen)
Internal Backpack, Spare car key
Poop Kit (plastic shovel, toilet paper, baby wipes, small plastic garbage bags and twist ties)
Reading glasses in a hard case
Pack cover (rain cover), Peter the Hiking Bear
Crocs (camp shoes and stream crossings)
