1. Is a Backcountry Permit needed?
For example permits are needed for: Grand Canyon, Havasupai
2. Is there a limit on the number of people?
For example the Grand Canyon has a limit of 10 people
3. Is there any special restrictions?
For example: trail closures, no fires, Eagle breeding season
4. What are the driving directions to the trailhead?
5. How long is the drive?
Should we leave at 7:00 AM or should we leave earlier?
6. What is the length of the hike?
What is the trail profile?
How many feet up and how many feet down?
Do we have a map of the hike?
7. Is there enough seatbelts?
8. Has a BSA Tour permit been filed?

9. Is any special training needed at a Troop meeting before the trip?
For example before a Canoe trip: Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat
10. Any girls on the trip?

For example cold weather: long underwear needed
For example a canoe trip: canoes, PFDs, paddles, extra water, etc
