- Goes to Philmont Chaplain Aide meeting

Leave No Trace Guide –

- Helps the crew to practice Leave No Trace at Philmont
- Helps the crew earn the Wilderness Pledge Patch
- Goes to Philmont Leave No Trace Guide meeting

Crew Leader du jour

- Each Scout will do this one time, cooks food and cleans up for that day with Crew Leader for next day
- Is the second in line hiking, navigator for the day with a set of maps

First Aider -

- Takes Wilderness First Aid course, has some extra first aid supplies

Map/GPS Master –

- Has a GPS and a set of maps

Quartermaster –

- Helps Crew Leader du jour to pick up food, coordinates crew setting up dining fly,
- Gets crew equipment under dining fly

Tee-Shirt Designer –

- Designs crew tee-shirt

Photographer –

- Takes pictures for the Crew video

Song Master –

- Leads songs at campfires
