Girl Scouts Backpacking II

Trailhead

1. Find the trailhead on a Topographic Map.
2. Find the trailhead on a state highway map.
3. Find the trailhead on the Arizona Atlas & Gazetteer.
4. Draw a simple map showing how to drive from the Camp Sombrero to the trailhead.
5. How many hours are needed to drive to the trailhead.?
6. Share with the group. What resources did you use and how did you use them?

Materials Needed:

1. State highway map
2. Pencil and paper
3. Arizona Atlas & Gazetteer
4. Topographic 7.5 minute map



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Trail

1. Point out the trail on a 7.5 minute USGS topographic map.
2. Draw a trail profile. (distance on trail vs elevation)
for every 0.1 mile plot the elevation
3. What is the elevation at the start of the trail?
4. What is the elevation at the end of the trail?
5. What is the length of the trail?
6. How much time will it take to hike this trail?
(2 miles per hour, plus 1 hour for each 1,000 ft elevation change)
7. Share with the group. What resources did you use and how did you use them?

Materials Needed:

1. 7.5 minute topographic map of trail
2. Pencil and paper
